Recently, she also joined the programme board of FORNY2020, which is the Research Council of Norway's programme on commercialising R&D results. Jeanette has been involved in several successful grant applications from both regional, national and EU programmes. Currently, she is a work package leader in the ERA-NET Mbt project Neptuna, H2020 RISE project OceanMedicines and the H2020 ITN project MarPipe. Her research interest and focus is the discovery of novel bioactive compounds in marine environments.
